Royal Serenade Pink 2610-14 1/2 Yard



DeVine Orange 2630-10 5/8 Yard



Magic Carpet Pink 2640-14 1/2 Yard



Savanah Red 2650-06 1/2 Yard



Helicopter Bird Burgundy 2670-35 1-1/3 Yards



Summer Bloom Yellow 2660-08 1/2 Yard

PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING

- * All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam allowance.
- * RST = right sides together



DeVine Pink 2630-14 1 Yard, includes binding



White Solid 1-1/3 Yards

PLUS Backing: 3-2/3 Yards

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cutting Based on 42" wide fabric (WOF-Width of Fabric)

From Fabric A cut: * (9) 5-1/2" squares

From Fabric B cut: * (36) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

From Fabric C cut: * (8) 6" squares

From Fabric D cut: * (8) 6" squares

From Fabric E cut: * (2) 6" squares

* (6) 4-1/2" x WOF strips for outer border

* (32) 3" squares

From Fabric F cut: * (40) 3" squares

From Fabric G cut:

* (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding

* (5) 2" x WOF strips for inner border


From Fabric H cut:

* (18) 6" squares

* (36) 3" x 5-1/2" pieces

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (18) 6" H squares. Pair (1) marked square RST with (1) 6" C square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on the line, and press both HSTs open. Trim to measure 5-1/2" square. Make a total of (16) C-H units. In the same way, make (16) D-H units and (4) E-H units.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (40) 3" F squares. Position (1) marked square RST on the left end of (1) 3" x 5-1/2" H piece. Sew on the line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press open. Repeat on the right end of the piece. Make (20) F-H flying geese units. Make (16) E-H flying geese units.





3. Sew (1) 3" x 5-1/2" B rectangle to (1) F-H flying geese unit. Make (20) F star point units. In the same manner, make (16) E star point units.



BLOCK CONSTRUCTION


4. Lay out (4) C-H units, (4) F star point units, and (1) 5-1/2" A square into (3) rows of (3) units. Sew into rows and join the rows to make (1) C-F block measuring 15-1/2" square. Make (4).





5. In the same way, make (4) D-E blocks and (1) E-F block.





- **4.** Measure the quilt through the horizontal center (side to side) of the quilt. Trim (2) strips to this length. Matching centers and ends, pin and sew to sides.
- **5.** Repeat steps 2-4 using the (6) 4-1/2" x WOF E strips to add the outer border.

FINISHING

- **1.** Cut backing fabric into (2) equal lengths and sew together to make the quilt back.
- **2.** Layer top, batting and pieced backing. Baste if necessary and quilt as desired.
- **3.** Sew the (6) 2-1/4" x WOF G binding strips short ends together with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Fold in half lengthwise wrong sides together and sew to quilt with a French binding technique. Fold binding to back and hand sew down.

Be sure to put a label on the back and ENJOY!

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Follow the quilt layout diagram on the next page for sewing the blocks together.

- **1.** Lay out the blocks into (3) rows of (3) blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.
- **2.** Sew the (5) 2" x WOF G strips short ends together with diagonal seams. Press seams open.
- **3.** Measure the quilt through the vertical center (top to bottom) of the quilt. Trim (2) strips to this length. Matching centers and ends, pin and sew to sides.
